"Talofa lava and good evening everyone,

Tonight, as I stand before you, I am overwhelmed with emotion and deep gratitude. It is a rare and humbling privilege to be part of a milestone like this — twenty years of SVSG serving our beloved Samoa.

Twenty years ago, a small group of people came together with one powerful idea — to be a refuge for the vulnerable, a voice for the voiceless, and a shield for those without one. What began as a spark of compassion has grown into a movement of courage, advocacy, and healing.

SVSG was born not out of resources, but out of heart — and today, we look around and see the incredible impact of that heart.
